

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF EXTRADITION OFFICIALS

RESOLUTION #45

WHEREAS, given the regular use of electronics, federal, state, and local courts are permitting the electronic filing of legal documents, including documents relevant to the interstate extradition process; and

WHEREAS, it is the expressed purpose of the National Association of Extradition Officials to secure uniformity in the interpretation, practice, and procedures of extradition effectuated pursuant to the Uniform Criminal Extradition Act, and related laws;

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the National Association of Extradition Officials at the 55th annual training conference in Roanoke, Virginia, that this Association recommends to extradition officials in the United States that they accept for the purpose of interstate extradition all electronically signed court documents and electronically filed documents, if the electronically signed and/or filed documents are filed by the court and the copies certified by an appropriate custodian of records.
